

GAME 1 No. 3 ALASKA ANCHORAGE vs. No. 6 HAWAI'I PACIFIC

**LA JOLLA, Calif.** — Hannah Wandersee scored 22 points with six rebounds to lift Anchorage Alaska to a victory over Hawai'i Pacific, 76-69, on Friday afternoon in the NCAA West Region quarterfinals at RIMAC Arena.

Starr Rivera led Hawai'i Pacific with 18 points.

HPU outscored Anchorage 19-18 in the third quarter to pull within eight, 55-47 heading into the fourth quarter.

A Tara Thompson 3-pointer extended the Seawolves' lead to 11 early in the fourth, and an offensive rebound and bucket inside by Tennae Voliva made it 68-57 with 5:20 to go.

Two free throws by HPU's Alysha Marucci pulled the Sharks within three, 72-69, with 45 seconds remaining, but two free-throws at the other end by Anchorage's Sydni Stallworth made it 75-69 with 30 seconds left to play.
