

LA JOLLA, Calif. — Rachel Bozlee scored a game-high 19 points to lift Azusa Pacific past Cal Poly Pomona, 62-60, in the NCAA West Region quarterfinals Friday night at RIMAC Arena. Kasey Smit led Cal Poly Pomona with 15 points, as the Broncos held a slim one-point lead heading into the fourth quarter. However, APU's Savanna Hanson made two clutch free-throws to break a 60-60 tie with 15 seconds remaining in the game. Cal Poly senior Jordyn Shane got a good look with time winding down, but her jumper bounced off the rim as Azusa Pacific moves on to Saturday's west region semifinals against UC San Diego at 7:30 p.m.
