If two or more teams finish in a tie, they shall split the points for their combined place-finishes. The Conference Tournament champion shall receive one extra point. (9/16) Individual sports shall be scored as follows: (9/16)

Cross country, track and field

Points shall be awarded based on place finish at the CCAA Championships. (9/16)

Men's golf

Points shall be awarded based on finish at the CCAA Championships as follows: (9/16)

1st Place – Team Championship Match Play winner (9/16)

2nd Place – Team Championship Match Play runner-up (9/16)

3rd and 4th Place – Match Play semifinalists (teams split the points for their combined finish

(9/16)

The remaining teams shall be awarded points based on stroke play results. (9/16)

**Each institution shall select two fall sports, two winter sports, two spring sports, and two additional sports**

from any season to determine its final institutional score. The institution with the greatest sum of its eight

selected sports shall be the winner of the Hiegert Cup (9/16).
